

Our Facebook fan total grew to 630 fans and our Twitter network increased to 110 followers. We also added a Flickr page to post patrons' artwork and a YouTube page to highlight different events hosted at the library. A new Staff Picks category was designed to complement our NextReads readers' advisory service.







This year also the Children's and Teen pages were transformed into blogs, and overall the total visits of these pages along with the main page were 80,721.

eBooks, New Resources and Librarian by Appointment

In 2011, the Nutley Public Library circulated 902 digital eBooks / digital audio books. We also acquired new online resources: Universal Class, which has over 500 online, self—paced continuing education courses and Muzzy, an online language program for children. To help patrons with various questions that may require more time at the reference desk, librarian by appointment classes are offered to Nutley residents. Nearly 50 librarian by appointment classes were taught in 2011.
