2 Days:

New and high demand DVDs and Blu-Rays, and museum passes

7 Days:

New music CDs, vinyl records, turntables and new video games.

14 Days:

WiFi hotspots, high demand and new books, travel guides, video games, audiobooks, music CDs, DVDs, and Blu-Rays, Kindles

28 Days:

Fiction and nonfiction, graphic novels, test guides, and readalongs

Loan Fee/Rental:

All items are free; museum passes require a refundable \$40 deposit

Renewals:

All items can be renewed except for high demand items, and items on hold.

Overdue fees per day:

Books, music, and audiobooks are \$.10 DVDs, Blu-Rays, and video games are \$1 WiFi hotspots are \$5

Maximum Fees:

Maximum fees for all items overdue are \$20. Museum passes forfeit the \$40 dollar deposit if returned late.
